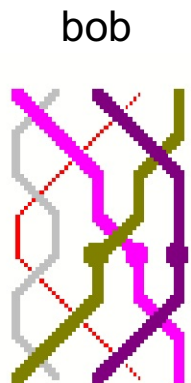
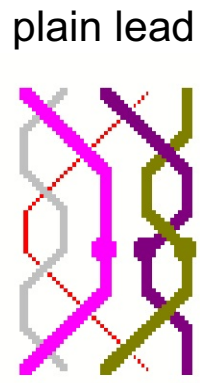
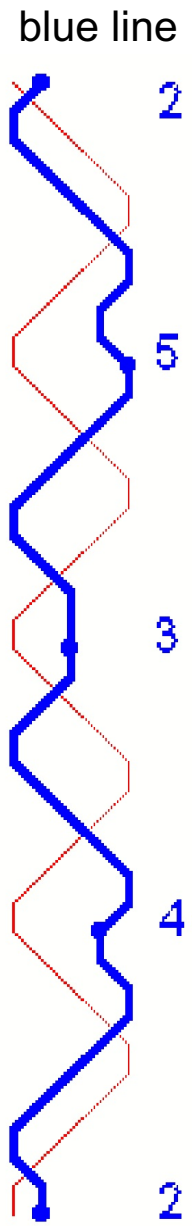
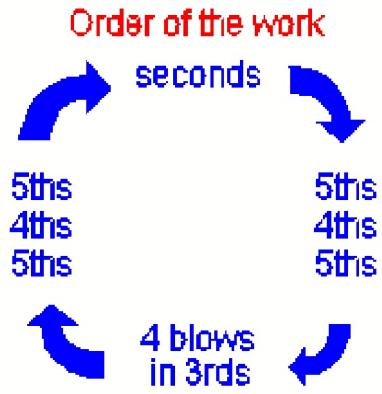


All Saints Doubles



The treble plain hunts. The bells in 2-3 at the lead end do the same work as in a Grandsire single - seconds and long thirds. The bells in 4-5 make 5ths - 4ths - 5ths (sometimes referred to as "crankhandles"). The bob is a plain lead of Reverse Canterbury.



By place passing treble going up			
	pass treble	at plain lead	at bob
●	1-2	make seconds	unaffected (make seconds)
●	2-3	make 4 blows in 3rds	3-4 places up
●	3-4	5ths 4ths 5ths	4 blows in 5ths
●	4-5	5ths 4ths 5ths	3-4 places down
